

Bachelor in Physical Therapy Program Achievements

- Development of the “Bridging” study plan (1435-1436 H) for old technicians who graduated from the program before the approval of the bachelor’s degree program from Taif University and enabling them to hold the bachelor degree in physical therapy for filling the gap in the work market at that time.
- Establishment of the “Master’s degree in Musculoskeletal Physical Therapy” to enrich the graduate clinical skills especially in one of the common physical therapy specialties.
- Ten of the teaching staff in the program hold an “Item Writer” certificate from the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties.
- Graduating ten batches of qualified graduate students from the program serving the Saudi rehabilitation market.
- Scientific cooperation with different organizations, such as Al-Hada Armed Forces Hospital, through staff participation in scientific meeting about “Shoulder Joint” held in the hospital (2014)
- The program established an expertise house: “Designing a sound workplace” (1442-1443 H).
- Approval of the “Out clinic project” at the CAMS, including Physiotherapy clinic to serve the TU staff.
- The program, in association with other programs at the CAMS, got a high score in the provision of academic counseling at the TU level (1442-1443 H).
- The CAMS, represented by its four programs, was awarded as one of the best colleges in the trimester transformation project (1442-1443 H).
- One of the program’s faculty was awarded the best academic file in the CAMS for the year 1439-1440 H.
- One of the program’s faculty published a scientific paper in “Nature” periodical (2019).
- One of the program’s faculty has achieved the status of Fellow (FHEA) in recognition of attainment against the UK Professional Standards Framework for teaching and learning support in higher education.
- One of the program’s faculty was awarded for the scientific publication (1434-1435 H).
- One of the program’s faculty was a member in the committee for the 4th standard “Teaching and Learning” during the preparation for the institutional accreditation (1435 H).
