





Ranking Surveys

Taif University is making a determined effort to improve its international visibility and status. One way of doing this is to perform well in various global university rankings.

Over the next few months international ranking agencies will be contacting researchers who have published in indexed academic journals or have engaged in international research activities and asking them to take part in a survey. We would encourage researchers to take part in these surveys if they have the chance in order to enhance the reputation of your university.

There are three international surveys. They will ask you to select the best universities for research, but you should be aware of some important differences between them.

The Times Higher Education (THE) imposes no restriction on the universities you can nominate. It asks about best universities for teaching as well as research. QS does not allow researchers to nominate the university where they are working. The Clarivate Analytics survey does not allow researchers to nominate their employer or their alma mater.
