## Introduction:

- To assess the prevalence of Gingivitis among the school going children of Taif city
- To assess the prevalence of Fluorosis among the school going children of Taif city
- To provide dental health education to the school going children of Taif city
- To provide appropriate preventive and promotive measures to reduce the incidence of common oral diseases.
